

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2009 Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services,
Division of Community Health - FY 09 Family Violence Services Grant)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-281

1 **WHEREAS, prevention of injuries is a priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

2 **WHEREAS, domestic violence is a source of injuries from the individuals and family members;**

3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Violence Program of the Health and Human Services-Community Health**
5 **Division and the Domestic Violence Coalition is working to raise awareness of**
6 **domestic violence and continue the development of services for domestic violence**
7 **victims and their families; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services received a**
9 **Family Violence Prevention and Services grants in FY-09 for a total of \$138,371.00; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the grant has expenditure period effective, May 10, 2008 and ending September 30,**
11 **2010; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Administration from Children and Families requests authorization to expend**
13 **funds from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009 of this grant in the amount of**
14 **\$138,371.00.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

16 **1. Accepts and approves the grant award DHHS/ACF Violence Prevention and**
17 **Services Budget effective May 10, 2008 and ending September 30, 2010 and**
18 **authorizes the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$138,371.00.**

19 **2. Approves the Family Violence Prevention and Services budget and authorizes the**
20 **Department of Health and Human Services Community Health Division to**
21 **expend such funds retro active to October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009 in**
22 **the amount \$138,371.00.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated official**
25 **are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
26 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**
27 **further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH. Day**
29 **of MAY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
30 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
31 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
32 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
33 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


