

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Amending Resolution No. 08-310, "Approving the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office FY - 2009 TERO/EEOC budget 13-1070")

RESOLUTION NO. 08-311

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights Office since**
2 **1978 and has successfully met the needs of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office has**
4 **been supplemented by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission in the**
5 **amount of \$26,000.00; and**
6 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is to increase**
7 **employment of Indians on and near the Tohono O'odham Nation by enforcing Indian**
8 **Preference in employment, training, contracting, subcontracting and eradicate**
9 **employment discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the Tohono O'odham**
10 **Nation; and**
11 **WHEREAS, the contract between the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the**
12 **Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office has been approved by the Office**
13 **of the Chairman in the amount of \$26,000.00.**
14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
15 **approves and adopts the continued supplemental funding for the Tribal**
16 **Employment Rights Office FY 2009 Equal Employment Opportunity Commission**
17 **Budget in the amount of \$26,000.**
18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council hereby authorizes**
19 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
20 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall**
21 **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that Resolution No. 08-310, is hereby amended to correct the years in**
23 **the resolved clause as October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28TH. Day**
25 **of MAY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
26 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2)(3)**
27 **& (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**
