16		grant funding in the amount of \$60,000.00 that EPA has awarded to the Tohono

19		expenditure of funds according to this budget, which shall be in effect from October					
20		1, 2008 to September 30, 2009.

22		O'odham Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated					
23		official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however,

25		submitted for further prior approval.
