10	,	prices that greatly affect the Nation's members due to essential personal
11		transportation costs due to the long distances to travel for any services; and
12		increasing costs of food; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Indian Health Service opposes amendments proposed in Senate Bill 1200, Health
14	, , , , , , , , , , , , , , , , , , ,	Care Improvement Act amendments that would enable certain tribes contracting
15		with I.H.S. under 638 Title V agreements to charge its members for health care
16		services; and

	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Executive Office and Legislative Council support the position
18		of the I.H.S. opposing the amendments in S.B. 1200 relating to cost sharing.
19	NOW, THER	EFORE BE, IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby supports the position of
20		the Indian Health Service and opposes the amendments in S.B. 1200 that would allow
21		Tribes with agreements under Title V to cost-share health care costs with its
