13		Classificationcontainedin25CFR170androadinventoryupdatechangesapproved
14		by TribalResolutionNo.08-149datedMarch17, 2008andtoadopt theamendedTTIP
15		as the Nation's current (2008) Long Range Transportation Plan as a means of
16		reaffirming the Nation's transportation needs and supporting changes to the IRR
17		inventory to implement projects to meet those needs.

19		incorporate the new Functional Classifications contained in 25 CFR 170 and road
20		inventory updated changes approved by tribal resolution No.08-149 and adopts the
21		amended TTIP as the Nation's current (2008)Long Range Transportation Plan.
22	BE IT FURT	HER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby authorizes the BIA-Western
23		Regional Office, Division of Transportation, to take the necessary action to
24		implement projects based on the Tribe's current road construction priorities.

26		officials are authorized to execute the documents necessary to fulfill the intent of
27		this resolution.
