

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending the 2004 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Adopting
the Updated TIP as the Tohono O'odham Nation's 2008 Long Range
Transportation Plan)**

RESOLUTION NO. 08-372

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the Nation) is Federal Recognized Indian Tribe and the**
2 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (the Legislative Council) is the governing body**
3 **of the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Nation completed a Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP) in 2004**
5 **that identified road improvement projects to meet long range (20-year) Tribal**
6 **transportation needs; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council passed Resolution No.05-365, dated June 30, 2005, and**
8 **Resolution No.05-404, dated July 18, 2005, that prioritized road improvement**
9 **projects identified in the 2004 TTIP; and**

10 **WHEREAS, there are improvement projects identified in the 2004 TTIP that are still needed to**
11 **meet tribal transportation needs; and**

12 **WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the 2004 TTIP to incorporate the new Functional**
13 **Classification contained in 25 CFR 170 and road inventory update changes approved**
14 **by Tribal Resolution No.08-149 dated March 17, 2008 and to adopt the amended TTIP**
15 **as the Nation's current (2008) Long Range Transportation Plan as a means of**
16 **reaffirming the Nation's transportation needs and supporting changes to the IRR**
17 **inventory to implement projects to meet those needs.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council hereby amends the 2004 TTIP to**
19 **incorporate the new Functional Classifications contained in 25 CFR 170 and road**
20 **inventory updated changes approved by tribal resolution No.08-149 and adopts the**
21 **amended TTIP as the Nation's current (2008) Long Range Transportation Plan.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby authorizes the BIA-Western**
23 **Regional Office, Division of Transportation, to take the necessary action to**
24 **implement projects based on the Tribe's current road construction priorities.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Nation's Chairman or Vice Chairman and any designated**
26 **officials are authorized to execute the documents necessary to fulfill the intent of**
27 **this resolution.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH. Day**
29 **of JUNE, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,642.35 FOR; 316.9**
30 **AGAINST; 378.75 NOT VOTING; and 196.5[04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
31 **by Section 1 (i) of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
32 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






