

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Johnson O'Malley Program FY 2008 Budget Modification/Amendment
1 - Account # 10-1210)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-380

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Johnson O'Malley Program has provided**
2 **direct services to Native American students attending the Baboquivari Unified**
3 **School District, Gila Bend Unified School District and the Division of Early Childhood**
4 **Development; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has notified Grants and Contracts of the final allocation**
6 **modification #54 of \$125,826.00 for the FY-2008 Budget, with the indirect cost at**
7 **\$21,251.33 for a total amount of \$147,077.33; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the original estimated budget of \$109,560.00 has now been increased by \$16,266.00**
9 **for a total cost of \$125,826.00 with the indirect cost of \$17,721.09 which has now been**
10 **increased by \$3,530.24 for a total cost of \$21,251.33; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the FY-2008 Johnson O'Malley Program Modification/Amendment 1 will now include**
12 **a total of \$16,266.00 increased in line items 711 (Communications), 712 (Gas, Oil and**
13 **Coolants), 720 (Supplies-Office), 722 (Program Supplies), 771 (RM Vehicles), 810**
14 **(Professional Services), 812 (Public Relations), 867 (Awards).**


15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
16 **Johnson O'Malley Program, FY-2008 Budget Modification/Amendment 1 reflecting**
17 **the final allocation Modification #54 of \$125,826.00 for the FY-2008 Budget, with the**
18 **indirect cost at \$21,251.33 for a total amount of \$147,077.33.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman or Vice-Chairman is hereby**
20 **authorized to negotiate and execute the budget provided that any amendment**
21 **affecting the funding or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for approval**
22 **by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 26TH Day**
24 **of JUNE, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,127.05 FOR; 316.9**
25 **AGAINST; 90.55 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
26 **Section 1 (9) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
27 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
29 **Stat. 984).**
