

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tohono O'odham Utility Authority Pia Oik Waterline corridor
Right-of-Way, Gu-Vo District, Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-393

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council convened at a scheduled meeting on June**
2 **27, 2008; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 08-70 the Nation established the Papago Tribal Utility Authority,**
4 **now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) for purposes of**
5 **constructing, maintaining and operating various utility systems within the Nation**
6 **to be owned wholly by the Nation; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did pass Resolution No. 91-175 (Adopting**
8 **Second Restated Plan of Operation for the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority) which**
9 **requires the Authority to submit for prior review and approval of the Legislative**
10 **Council and each affected District any proposed utility easement; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, TOUA requests permission for combined Right-of-Way to add a new Waterline**
12 **corridor and related facilities and utilities for the community of Pia Oik, Gu-Vo**
13 **District, Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, the requested combined right-of-way for the new Waterline corridor measures**
15 **1,857.19 FT in length x 50 FT in width which encompasses 2.13 acres more or less; and**
- 16 **WHEREAS, TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents and pertinent information**
17 **(incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized purposes**
18 **of TOUA; and**
- 19 **WHEREAS, the TOUA Pia Oik Waterline corridor Right-of-Way and related facilities and utilities**
20 **will be of substantial benefit to the Pia Oik community, Gu-Vo District, Tohono**
21 **O'odham Nation and their respective members; and**
- 22 **WHEREAS, the Gu- Vo District Council did approve the Right-of-Way request by enactment of**
23 **Resolution No. GV08-054; and**
- 24 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee reviewed the requested Right-of-Way on June 19,**
25 **2008 and by consensus does recommend further approval thereof by the Tohono**
26 **O'odham Legislative Council.**
- 27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
28 **approve the Right-of-Way as requested by TOUA for the Waterline corridor and**
29 **related facilities in the location (as more fully described in the referenced map and**
30 **supporting documents) and construction by TOUA or its designated subsidiaries for**
31 **uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA.**
