5	WHEREAS, Indian Health Service has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4) most							
6	critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall prioritization of							
7	projects; and							
8	WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided							
9	recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council regarding the most							
10	critical needs.							
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed							
12	and approved the entire priority list and has determined that the following							
13	deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending order of							
14	prioritization:							
15	1. Scattered Water and Sewer Project							
16	2. Septic System Replacement							
17	3. N. Hickiwan Water & Sewer							
18	4. Gunsight Water & Sewer
