

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the FY 2008 Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services,**  
**Division of Community Health - Department of Justice, Office of Violence Against Indian**  
**Women Discretionary Grant to Indian Tribal Governments, Budget Modification and**  
**Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 08-439**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the TODHHS, Division of Community Health**  
2 **Service, is administering a Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Violence Against**  
3 **Indian Women Discretionary Grant to Indian Tribal Governments; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the DOJ, Violence Against Indian Women Grant is for a three-year period, from**  
5 **October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2010; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the twelve month FY 2008 DOJ grant budget was approved through Resolution No. 08-**  
7 **020; and**

8 **WHEREAS, there are anticipated over expenditure in travel, program supplies, and food; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the redistribution of funds includes a \$4,870.75 decrease in Professional Services**  
10 **which is a pass-through account; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the net result of the Professional Service decrease is an Indirect Cost Charge increase**  
12 **of \$870.75.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

14 **1. Approves the Department of Justice, Violence Against Indian Women Grant to**  
15 **Indian Tribal Governments Budget Modification and Amendment No. 1 for the**  
16 **realignment of program funds.**

17 **2. Approves the \$870.75 increase in the Indirect Cost amount.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
19 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated official**  
20 **are authorized to administer and expend these funds, provided however, that any**  
21 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted**  
22 **for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
24 **of JULY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of**  
26 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
27 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
