

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the University of North Carolina – Chapel Hill Evaluation IGA For the
FY 2008 Motor Vehicle Injury Prevention STOP Project)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-445

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Motor Vehicle Injury Prevention Grant,**
2 **known as the Securing Tohono O'odham People (STOP) Project; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did receive notice of award of \$71,480.00 for year four of**
4 **the STOP project; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the STOP project year four funding was approved by Resolution No. 08-040; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the FY 2008 STOP project continuation budget did include an evaluation cost of**
7 **\$11,000.00 for the conduct of both of a process and outcome evaluation in order to**
8 **maximize project success, credibility and sustainability; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the University of North Carolina (UNC) – Chapel Hill have previously been contracted**
10 **by the Nation for the STOP project evaluation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has determined that the STOP project evaluation shall,**
12 **in year four, be conducted by the UNC via an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA); and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the**
14 **appropriate parties of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and the University of North**
15 **Carolina.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
17 **approve the Intergovernmental Agreement for the provision of evaluation services by**
18 **the University of North Carolina – Chapel Hill, as provided in the form attached hereto.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Chairman**
20 **of the Nation to execute it and any subsequent amendments, and authorizes the**
21 **Nation's Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Community Health**
22 **Service to implement the agreement.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
24 **of JULY, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**
26 **& (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
27 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
29 **Stat. 984).**
