11	WHEREAS,	eight of the twelve proposed monitor well locations are on the Nation's land outside

13		A through H on the attached map, and the remaining four monitor well locations are

27	WHEREAS,	at a meeting on July 12, 2008 the Sif Oidak District Council passed Resolution No.
28		SODC-08-087 and thereby approved the monitor well drilling program and
29		geophysical testing, including the locations for wells "A" through "G" located outside

RESOLUTION NO. <u>08-478</u> (Approving Installation of Eight Additional Monitor Wells by Cyprus Tohono Corporation Near the Community of North Komelik and Approving Additional Geophysical Testing) Page 2 of 3 the leases: and WHEREAS, since July 12 the number of wells outside of the lease boundaries has changed from seven to eight, due to further investigation of well site "H" as shown on the attached map, which Cyprus Tohono has proposed moving a few hundred yards to the west in order to gain access to the site without destroying vegetation, which re-located well site will be reviewed with the Sif Oidak District Council before the well is drilled. NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council: Approves the drilling and construction of seven monitor wells near North **(1)** Komelik at the locations shown as "A" through "G", and approves the eighth monitor well at location "H" contingent upon approval of the site by the Sif Oidak District Council, all as shown on the attached map, which wells will be owned by the Nation upon completion of construction; and (2)

- Authorizes Cyprus Tohono personnel and their consultants to access the well sites and the wells after completion of construction for the purposes of the groundwater monitoring program related to the Cyprus Tohono mine, on the condition that Cyprus Tohono provide to the Nation's Water Resources Department any data obtained from these wells and agrees that the Nation's Water Resources Department can obtain split samples of the drill cuttings and water samples; and
- Authorizes the additional geophysical testing outside the lease boundaries using the "electrical resistivity method" on the condition that any data obtained from such testing be shared with the Nation's Water Resources Department.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>06TH.</u> Day of AUGUST, 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0-AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>[01]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article XVII, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
