

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Grantees for the Disbursement of the fiscal year 2008 Gaming Compact**  
**Section 12(d) 12% Contribution )**

**RESOLUTION NO. 08-493**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 02-562, the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") approved a new**  
2 **tribal-state gaming compact (the "Compact") with the State of Arizona; and**

3 **WHEREAS, as part of Section 12 of the Compact, the Nation did agree to make certain tribal**  
4 **contributions in consideration for substantial exclusivity covenants by the State; and**

5 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 12(d) of the Compact, the Nation agreed to contribute twelve**  
6 **percent of the tribal contribution (the "12% Distribution") to cities, towns, and**  
7 **counties, for services that benefit the general public; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the next disbursement of the 12% Distribution is due on October 25, 2008; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee of the Legislative Council and the Chairman of the Nation**  
10 **jointly recommend approval of the following grantees for the designated purpose and**  
11 **in the specified amount.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
13 **and designates the following named recipients of the 12% Distribution funding to**  
14 **receive the amounts shown below, totaling \$1,497,915.54 dollars, which shall be used**  
15 **for the Nation's designated purpose:**

16 **Casa Grande**

- 17 1. **\$62,288.00 for the Casa Grande Fire Department to purchase protective**  
18 **equipment (\$17,700), shelters (\$11,088) and a community service vehicle (\$33,500).**  
19 2. **\$15,000.00 for Cesar E. Chavez Memorial Committee of Pinal County to fund youth**  
20 **scholarships.**  
21 3. **\$45,848 for Against Abuse Inc. to fund playground equipment (\$41,848) and**  
22 **computers (\$4,000).**

23 **Douglas**

- 24 4. **\$99,000.00 for the Society of St. Vincent de Paul to fund a new roof.**

25 **Eloy**

- 26 5. **\$9,000.00 for the City of Eloy to purchase four public access laptop computers and**  
27 **software configured for Spanish for the city library.**

28 **Gila Bend**

- 29 6. **\$127,000.00 for Gila Bend Fire/Rescue to purchase a new ambulance.**

30 **Phoenix**

- 31 7. **\$50,000.00 for Kids Voting Arizona to sponsor a program that provides civics**  
32 **curriculum to teachers in an effort to increase voter participation in Arizona.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
27 **authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute Grant Agreements with the above**  
28 **named recipients.**

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise is hereby directed to issue**  
30 **checks in the amounts approved above to either the grantee or the flow-through**  
31 **municipality, if such government municipality is provided in parenthesis above,**  
32 **pursuant to information provided by the Executive Office; the checks shall be issued**  
33 **no later than Saturday, October 25, 2008 and shall be mailed via certified mail with**  
34 **copies of the approved grant agreement to the points of contact provided by the**  
35 **Executive Office.**


