LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Authorizing Execution of Website Service Agreements)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 08-509

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with the
2		power to "negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono
3		O'odham Nation with private persons or organizations on all matters within the
4		authority of the Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Council has prescribed the duties and powers of the Council Chairman and Vice
6		Chairman (collectively, "legislative officers") by adopting the Legislative Rules and
7		by passing Legislative Order No. 06-047, "Amended Delegation of Authority to
8		Legislative Council Chairperson and Vice Chairperson"; and
9	WHEREAS,	although Legislative Order No. 06-047 expressly delegates to the legislative officers
10		the authority to negotiate, execute, and administer certain contracts, the officers are
11		not authorized to enter contracts that "indemnify a third party or authorize
12		payment of an award of attorney fees or costs of litigation or arbitration, unless
13		previously authorized by a majority vote of the Legislative Council"; and
14	WHEREAS,	the legislative officers, with assistance from staff in the Legislative Attorney's Office,
15		and Legislative Secretary's Office, have prepared content for a Legislative Branch
16		website, and have contracted with a Native American website designer to launch the
17		website by the end of FY 2008; and
18	WHEREAS,	the officers have selected Verio, Inc. and its third-party vendors, Melbourne IT
19		Limited, and Iron Mountain Information Management, Inc., to provide web hosting,
20		domain name registration, and backup services at a monthly fee of \$12.95 as these
21		services are not currently available in-house; and
22	WHEREAS,	the agreements to obtain these services do not expressly require the Nation to waive
23		its sovereign immunity but do include indemnification clauses and other provisions
24		that require Legislative Council approval; and
25	WHEREAS,	the legislative officers have researched alternative web hosting service agreements
26		but these agreements also contain provisions that prevent the officers from
27		executing them in accordance with Legislative Order No. 06-047; and
28	WHEREAS,	it is in the Legislative Council's best interest to give the Nation's members access to
29		current Council calendars, committee memberships, contact information, laws, and
30		other information through a Legislative Branch website.

1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it authorizes							
2	the Legislative Council officers to enter into the "Hosting and DNR and Backup							
3	Services Agreement" and all the agreements incorporated by reference (collectively,							
4	"Website Service Agreements"); provided that nothing in this delegation or in the							
5	Website Service Agreements shall be deemed a waiver of the Nation's sovereign							
6	immunity.
