RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Granting Temporary Distribution Date Extension)

RESOLUTION NO. 08-516

1	WHEREAS.	pursuant to Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, the Tohono
2	1	O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to manage "proceeds derived
3		from lands and resources of the Tohono O'odham Nation" and to enact laws,
4		ordinances, and resolutions necessary or incidental to the exercise of its legislative
5		powers (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and Section 1(l)); and
6		the Legislative Council has enacted an Ordinance for Regulation of Gaming Activities
7		Within the Tohono O'odham Nation, Ordinance No. 93-01 ("Gaming Ordinance")
8		(Resolution No. 93-296, as amended); and
9		the Gaming Ordinance provides that all gaming activities conducted within the Nation
10		shall be owned entirely by the Nation and conducted and operated by a tribal
10		enterprise; and
12		the Legislative Council has also enacted the Charter of the Gaming Enterprise
12		("Enterprise Charter") by Resolution No. 93-311, as amended, and thereby established
13		the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise ("Gaming Enterprise"), which was formerly
15		known as the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority; and
15		the Gaming Enterprise is a tribal governmental enterprise of the Nation established
10		pursuant to Article VI of the Nation's Constitution and is responsible for operating the
18		Nation's gaming facilities and conducting gaming activities in compliance with the
10		requirements of the Gaming Ordinance; and
20		pursuant to Section 7(e) of the Enterprise Charter, "The Enterprise shall pay to the
20		Nation as a distribution all available cash at the end of each month of operation.
21		Distribution shall take place by the fifth banking day of the succeeding month."; and
22		the Legislative Commerce and Budget and Finance Committees have conferred with
23 24		
24 25		the Nation's Chairman and Treasurer and with the Gaming Enterprise Board concerning the timing of distribution payments to the Nation under Section 7(e); and
26 27		the Committees and Nation's Chairman have reached a consensus that the best
27		interests of the Nation and the Gaming Enterprise will be served by temporarily
28 20		extending the timing of distribution payments to the Nation for an additional ten days
29 20		during the months of October 2008 through March 2009.
30	,	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
31		distribution payment dates set forth in Enterprise Charter Section 7(e) are hereby
32		extended for an additional ten days during the months of October 2008 through March

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1	2009; such payments shall therefore be due to the Nation on the fifteenth day of							
2	October, November, and December 2008, and the fifteenth day of January, February,							
3	and March 2009; provided that if the fifteenth day of the month is a non-banking day,							
4	the distribution payment shall be due on the next banking day thereafter.							
5	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the distribution							
6	payment dates set forth in Enterprise Charter Section 7(e) shall otherwise remain in							
7	effect and distribution payments to the Nation shall again be due the fifth banking day							
8	of the month of April 2009 and thereafter unless an additional extension is approved							
9	by Legislative Council resolution.

11	of <u>SEPTEMBER</u> , 2008 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,534.5</u> FOR; <u>-0-</u>

	Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
