### RESOLUTION NO. 08-721

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council convened at a scheduled meeting on
2		12/16/2008; and
3	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 08-70 the Nation established the Papago Tribal Utility Authority,
4		now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) for purposes of constructing,
5		maintaining and operating various utility systems within the Nation to be owned
6		wholly by the Nation; and
7	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did pass Resolution No. 91-175 (Adopting
8		Second Restated Plan of Operation for the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority) which
9		requires the Authority to submit for prior review and approval of the Legislative
10		Council and each affected District any proposed utility easement; and
11	WHEREAS,	TOUA requests permission for combined Right-of-Way to add a new Waterline and
12		related facilities and utilities for the community of Kukatch, Gu-Vo District, Tohono
13		O'odham Nation; and
14	WHEREAS,	the requested combined right-of-way for the New Waterline which measures
15		29,009.57 FT in length x 50 FT in width which encompasses 27.56 acres more or less;
16		and
17	WHEREAS,	TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents and pertinent information
18		(incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized purposes
19		of TOUA; and
20	WHEREAS,	the TOUA Kukatch Waterline Right-of-Way and related facilities and utilities will be
21		of substantial benefit to the Kukatch community, Gu-Vo District, Tohono O'odham
22		Nation and their respective members; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Gu- Vo District Council did approve the Right-of-Way request by enactment of
24		Resolution No. GV08-068; and
25	WHEREAS,	the Natural Resources Committee reviewed the requested Right-of-Way on
26		12/11/2008 and by consensus does recommend further approval thereof by the
27		Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
28	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
29		approve the Right-of-Way as requested by TOUA for the Kukatch Waterline and
30		related utilities and facilities in the location (as more fully described in the
