15		it necessary to provide funding for Miss Indian Arizona to ensure that she has the					
16		necessary accommodations to represent the Tohono O'odham Nation and the tribes					
17		of Arizona; and					
18	WHEREAS,	the proposed budget was presented to the Human Resources Development and					
19		Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative Council.					
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby						
21		approve the Miss Indian Arizona Budget in its form attached hereto and appropriates					
22		a one time funding amount of \$15,000.00 from existing FY 2008 Surplus funding to					
23		fund this Budget.
