**2007 State Homeland Security Grant for \$52,934.18, Grant #2007-GE-T7-0006)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 09-258**

- 1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has distributed grants to**  
2 **counties, through their respective states, to fund for purchases that provide public**  
3 **safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive funds through the respective state,**  
5 **requiring tribes to sign a Letter of Offer and Acceptance; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated a Letter of Offer and Acceptance with the**  
7 **State of Arizona for the purpose of obligating and distributing funds from the U.S.**  
8 **Department of Homeland Security, Office of Domestic Preparedness, 2007 Department**  
9 **of Homeland Security, State Homeland Security Program Grant No. 2007-GE-T7-0006**  
10 **on a reimbursement basis for purchase of necessary equipment to fulfill the security**  
11 **and operations improvements required for the Police Department; and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, the attached Letter of Offer and Acceptance was approved in the form attached hereto**  
13 **by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been awarded a grant from the Arizona Department**  
15 **of Emergency and Military Affairs, in the amount of \$52,934.18 as part of the 2007 State**  
16 **Homeland Security Program for purchase of necessary equipment to fulfill the**  
17 **security and operations improvements required for the Police and Fire Departments;**  
18 **and**
- 19 **WHEREAS, the 2007 Department of Homeland Security, State Homeland Security Program Grant**  
20 **No. 2007-GE-T7-0006 approval the use of carry forward of unexpended funds of**  
21 **\$52,934.18 has been reviewed by the Grants & Contracts Department, Executive Office,**  
22 **Domestic Affairs Committee and Budget & Finance Committee, of which all**  
23 **recommend acceptance of the grant award by the Legislative Council.**
- 24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
25 **use of carry forward of unexpended funds for Grant No. 2007-GE-T7-0006 in the**  
26 **amount of \$52,934.18 on a reimbursement basis from the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
27 **General Fund for the purchase of necessary equipment to fulfill the security and**  
28 **operations improvements required for enhancing the Tohono O'odham Nation, Police**  
29 **Department and further waives any additional indirect costs to administer this grant.**

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Police and Fire Departments are authorized  
2 to expend funds from this grant in accordance with the terms of the 2007 State  
3 Homeland Security Program Grant No. 2007-GE-T7-0006 award period of 11/01/06 to  
4 07/31/09, with any extensions of time reasonably necessary which are approved by the  
5 granting agency to be brought back to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for  
6 approval.

7 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Office of  
8 the Chairman or designee to enter into any necessary agreements therefore accepting  
9 the above mentioned U.S. Department of Homeland Security, State Homeland Security  
10 Grants.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day  
12 of MAY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
13 -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article IV,  
14 Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
15 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
16 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
17 Stat. 984).
