14		with Title 7 CFR Subpart 246.6(a), is required to enter into a signed written agreement
15		with each Agency that sets forth the local agency's responsibilities for program
16		operations as prescribed in Title 7 CFR Subpart 246.6 (b); and
17	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation did enter into a Memorandum of Agreement, which was
18		approved through Resolution No. 02-439, with the ITCA to fund and operate the WIC
19		Program, which commenced on October 1, 2002; and
