8	technical assistance services to assist in the development of a strategy and
9	identification of strategies to achieve those goals through efforts to increase energy
10	efficiency, reduce fossil fuel emissions or by encouraging behavioral changes; and
11	WHEREAS, the ARRA Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant extends from September 23,
12	2009 through September 22, 2012.
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts
14	the ARRA Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant award of \$250,000.00.
15	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
16	Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
17	attached provide that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be
18	submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
