1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a three (3) year grant in the amount of**
2 **\$500,000.00 from the Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of**
3 **Justice Administration under the FY 2005 Indian Alcohol and Substance Abuse Media**
4 **Message and Public Information Campaign Program Grant; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Program will continue to provide intervention and prevention programs to assist**
6 **in the education and awareness of alcohol and substance abuse-related juvenile**
7 **crimes; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation submitted and was approved a No Cost Extension for the**
9 **period of July 01, 2009 through June 30, 2010; via email from Project Officer, Ms. Kate**
10 **Winton, and an approved Grant Adjustment Notice (GAN) posted on August 20, 2009;**
11 **and**

12 **WHEREAS, the unobligated balance ending FY July 01, 2008 – June 30, 2009 ending balance**
13 **amount of \$266,950.38 and this amount will be carried over for the budget beginning**
14 **July 01, 2009 through June 30, 2010.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
16 **approves the No Cost Extension on Grant Award No. 2005-AC-BX-0005 for the period of**
17 **July 01, 2009 – June 30, 2010.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves and**
19 **authorizes the expenditures of the attached FY 2010 budget for the Indian Alcohol and**
20 **Substance Abuse Program in the amount of \$266,950.38, as attached here to.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**
22 **Chairman to negotiate and execute the contracts and plans, provided, however, that**
23 **any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be**
24 **submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH. Day**
26 **of FEBRUARY, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
28 **VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**
