8	calculated at \$27,583.84; and
9	WHEREAS, under the first year's budget a new position has been created for a Criminal
10	Intelligence Analyst; and
11	WHEREAS, line items have been created under 660 Travel, 655 Lodging, 721 Supplies Other, 810
12	Professional Services, 750 Capital; and
13	WHEREAS, the total cost is \$239,152.13 with Indirect Cost at \$27,583.84 for a total of \$266,735.97.
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
15	accepts and approves the acceptance of the Department of Justice Office of Justice
16	Program Recovery Act Rural Law Enforcement Assistance: Combating Rural Crime in
17	the amount of \$394,724.00 for a two year period beginning August 1, 2009 thru July 31,
18	2011 and authorizes the Chairman to sign and execute the grants award.

20	Intelligence Analyst with IDC at \$27,583.84 for total budget cost for one year at
21	\$266,735.97 (see budget as attached hereto).
