1	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("the Nation") seeks to enter into a Memorandum of
2	Understanding (MOU) with the United States Marshals Service (USMS) on behalf of the
3	Nation's Police Department pursuant to the Presidential Threat Protection Act of 2000
4	to establish a Fugitive Apprehension Task Force that consists of Federal, State, and
5	local Law Enforcement authorities; and
6	WHEREAS, the Task Force will be directed and coordinated by the USMS for the purpose of
7	locating and apprehending fugitives; and
8	WHEREAS, the attached MOU has been reviewed by the Domestic Affairs Committee which
9	recommends Legislative Council approval.
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
11	the Memorandum of Understanding between the U.S. Marshals Service and the
12	Tohono O'odham Nation regarding a District Fugitive Apprehension Task Force
13	substantially in the form attached hereto, and hereby authorizes the Chairman of the
14	Nation to sign and execute the MOU with the United States Marshals Service.
15	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Chairman
16	and the Nation's Police Department to fully implement the MOU provided that any
17	amendments shall be submitted for full approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
18	Council.
19	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11^{TH} . Day
20	of FEBRUARY, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $2.184.50$ FOR; -0 -
21	AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 411.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
22	Article VI, Section 1 (f)(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
23	Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
	Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
25	18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
