8	amount of \$17,741.37; and
9	WHEREAS, this new budget would not affect Coldfields Community's original FY 2010 budget
10	amount of \$186,307.28, but would increase the overall Baboquivari District's FY 2010
11	current budget amount of \$1,898,555.51 to \$1,916,296.88.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves
13	Coldfields Community's new budget creation to utilize mining royalties in the amount
14	of \$17,741.37 and utilizing the two line items of 727.32 Building Materials in the
15	amount of \$8,870.69 and 810.32 Professional Services in the amount of \$8,870.68.
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this new budget creation will not affect the original FY 2010 budget
17	for Coldfields Community and will increase the overall FY 2010 budget for Baboquivari
18	District of \$1,898,555.51 to \$1,916,296.88.
19	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any modifications, amendments or changes in the justifications
20	shall be reviewed and approved by the Budget and Finance Committee and the Tohono
21	O'odham Legislative Council.
