

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Budget Amendment of the Brownfields Tribal Response
Program Amendment #2)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-117

1 **WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepted \$65,550.00 of funding for the**
2 **Amendment #1 of the Brownfields Tribal Response Program on September 22, 2009,**
3 **Resolution No. 09-497; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Brownfields Tribal Response Program extends from October 1, 2009 through**
5 **September 30, 2010; and**

6 **WHEREAS, there is an unobligated balance from FY 2009 in the amount of \$84,060.70; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the funding agency, USEPA has requested Indirect Costs not be included until the**
8 **Indirect Cost Agreement has been approved; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the program has made adjustments to the line items to reflect the unobligated**
10 **balance by making the appropriate adjustments to the current line items: 650 Tuition**
11 **& Registration; 655 Lodging; 660 Travel Expense; 720 Supplies - Office and adding**
12 **eleven new line items: 630 Insurance; 661 Mileage POV; 710 Utilities; 711**
13 **Communication Expense; 712 Gas, Oil and Coolants; 721 Supplies - Other; 722 Program**
14 **Supplies; 723 Uniforms; 730 Dues and Subscriptions; 771 RM Vehicles and 810**
15 **Professional Services.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
17 **the budget amendment #2 incorporating the unobligated balance of \$84,060.70 to the**
18 **current budget of \$65,550.00 for a total of \$149,610.70 in the following manner:**

- 20 **2. Increasing Line item 655 Lodging \$5,000.00**
- 21 **3. Increasing Line item 660 Travel Expense \$10,000.00**
- 22 **4. Increasing Line item 720 Supplies-Office \$3,000.00**
- 23 **5. Adding Line item 630 Insurance \$1,500.00**
- 24 **6. Adding Line item 661 Mileage POV \$2,600.00**
- 25 **7. Adding Line item 710 Utilities \$2,000.00**
- 26 **8. Adding Line item 711 Communication Expense \$3,600.00**
- 27 **9. Adding Line item 712 Gas, Oil and Coolants \$3,000.00**
- 28 **10. Adding Line item 721 Supplies - Other \$4,500.00**
- 29 **11. Adding Line item 722 Program Supplies \$5,360.70**
- 30 **12. Adding Line item 723 Uniforms \$1,500.00**

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1 **13. Adding Line item 730 Dues and Subscriptions \$1,000.00**

2 **14. Adding Line item 771 RM Vehicles \$2,500.00**

3 **15. Adding Line item 810 Professional Services \$35,000.00**

4 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that Tohono O'odham**
5 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are**
6 **hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
7 **amendments affecting the funding or funding level of the grant shall be submitted for**
8 **further prior approval.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
10 **of APRIL, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0-**
11 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
12 **Section 1 (f) Article VI, of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
13 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
14 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
15 **Stat. 984).**
