

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2010 Department of Health and Human Services Head Start Program,
American Recovery and Reinvestment Act)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-119

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**
2 **Department of Health and Human Services Head Start Program; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services under the American Recovery and**
4 **Reinvestment Act has awarded additional funds to Head Start programs; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated and wishes to continue operating a Head**
6 **Start Program to provide educational, health, mental health and parent involvement**
7 **services to children, three to five years of age; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Financial Assistance Award was awarded**
9 **in the amount of \$111,137.00; and**

10 **WHEREAS, on the award letter \$73,733.00 was budgeted for salaries and these salaries were**
11 **budgeted reflecting the personnel that were in positions at time of grant submission;**
12 **and**

13 **WHEREAS, the attached budget has \$73,606.25 budgeted for salaries due to a change in personnel,**
14 **making a difference of \$126.75; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch developed and obtained committee approval of the following**
16 **budget as attached and incorporated by this reference, to be effective July 1, 2009**
17 **through September 30, 2010 and request authorization to expand funds: American**
18 **Recovery and Reinvestment Act \$111,010.25.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
20 **the Department of Health and Human Services Head Start Program, American**
21 **Recovery and Reinvestment Act budget in the amount of \$111,010.25 as attached to**
22 **herein for the Period July 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010 and authorizes the**
23 **Executive Branch to expend the funds.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation's Officials, to wit, the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are**
26 **authorized to execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the**
27 **funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day of APRIL, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,413.65 FOR; 181.85 AGAINST; -01- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) Article VI, of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
