

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services,**  
**Division of Community Health Services, FY 2010 Public Health Preparedness and**  
**Response - Early Warning Infectious Disease Surveillance (EWIDS) Budget**  
**Amendment #1, Account #14-1482)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-134**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is concerned with the health, welfare and safety of its**  
2 **members who reside on or near the Tohono O'odham Nation Reservation, including**  
3 **the O'odham in Mexico; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Public Health Preparedness and Response for EWIDS is within the charter and**  
5 **mandate as provided by Resolution No. 07-100, affirming the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Department of Health and Human Services, as the Nation's public health authority;**  
7 **and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA),**  
9 **Contract No. HG954111, with the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) for**  
10 **(Public Health) Emergency Preparedness and Response with a start date of August 9,**  
11 **2008 (terminating on 08/08/2013); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the ADHS IGA, Contract No. HG954111, was approved by the Tohono O'odham**  
13 **Legislative Council by Resolution No. 09-123; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the ADHS Fiscal Year 2010 EWIDS funding notice was received, and the budget**  
15 **prepared in the amount of \$40,000.00 and was approved by the Tohono O'odham**  
16 **Legislative Council in Resolution No. 09-594; and**

17 **WHEREAS, this FY 2010 Public Health Preparedness and Response – Early Warning Infectious**  
18 **Disease Surveillance (EWIDS) now submits Budget Amendment #1 moving identified**  
19 **savings of \$16,953.23 from salary, fringe, and Indirect Cost; and**

20 **WHEREAS, a new line item, 810 Professional Services, has been added for a total amount of**  
21 **\$16,953.23.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 23 **1. Approves the Early Warning Infectious Disease Surveillance (EWIDS) Budget**  
24 **Amendment #1 moving savings from salary, fringe and IDC.**
- 25 **2. Approves adding line 810 Professional Services for amount \$16,953.23.**
- 26 **3. Approve a decrease to Indirect Cost of \$2,748.60.**
- 27 **4. Authorizes the Nation to obligate and expend funds, upon approval of this**  
28 **resolution, through August 8, 2010.**

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
30 **Nation officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice-Chairman or any designated official is**  
31 **hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**

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amendment affecting the funding or funding level shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup> Day of APRIL, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2)(3) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
