4	WHEREAS,	the Uniform Election Ordinance, Ordinance No.03-86, provides that "Upon the filing
5		of a valid initiative petition by the Election Board with the Tohono O'odham Council"
6		the Council "shall either adopt the initiative measure by a majority vote without
7		alteration or shall call for a special election to be held not later than ninety days after
8		the petition was filed with the council" (Election Ordinance Article XII, Section 9.A);

10	WHEREAS,	by its letter delivered May 14, 2010, the Election Board certified and notified the
11		Legislative Council chairperson that IN-01-2010, entitled "Regulating Salary
12		Increase(s) of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council," received a minimum of 300
13		valid signatures; and
14	WHEREAS,	based upon the Election Board's certification, the Legislative Council has called a
15		special election for August 7, 2010 to allow the Nation's voters to consider the Initiative the Consider the
16		(Legislative Order No. 10-188); and
17	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Article XII, Section 11.B., of the Election Ordinance,
18		"Not later than sixty (60) days preceding the election the council, after providing
19		reasonable opportunity for comments by all representatives, shall prepare and file
20		with the Election Board an analysis of the provisions of each ballot proposal of a
21		measure together with a list of popular arguments favoring and opposing each
22		$proposal.\ Each\ argument\ favoring\ and\ opposing\ each\ such\ proposal\ shall\ not\ exceed$
23		three hundred (300) words in length."; and
