

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Filing Analysis and Arguments Concerning Initiative No. IN-01-2010, "Regulating Salary Increase(s) of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council" as Required by Uniform Election Ordinance)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 10-201**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation reserves to the Nation's members "the**  
2 **power to independently propose ordinances, resolutions or other legislation affecting**  
3 **the Tohono O'odham Nation" by initiative (Constitution, Article XV); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Uniform Election Ordinance, Ordinance No.03-86, provides that "Upon the filing**  
5 **of a valid initiative petition by the Election Board with the Tohono O'odham Council"**  
6 **the Council "shall either adopt the initiative measure by a majority vote without**  
7 **alteration or shall call for a special election to be held not later than ninety days after**  
8 **the petition was filed with the council" (Election Ordinance Article XII, Section 9.A);**  
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, by its letter delivered May 14, 2010, the Election Board certified and notified the**  
11 **Legislative Council chairperson that IN-01-2010, entitled "Regulating Salary**  
12 **Increase(s) of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council," received a minimum of 300**  
13 **valid signatures; and**

14 **WHEREAS, based upon the Election Board's certification, the Legislative Council has called a**  
15 **special election for August 7, 2010 to allow the Nation's voters to consider the Initiative**  
16 **(Legislative Order No. 10-188); and**

17 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XII, Section 11.B., of the Election Ordinance,**  
18 **"Not later than sixty (60) days preceding the election the council, after providing**  
19 **reasonable opportunity for comments by all representatives, shall prepare and file**  
20 **with the Election Board an analysis of the provisions of each ballot proposal of a**  
21 **measure together with a list of popular arguments favoring and opposing each**  
22 **proposal. Each argument favoring and opposing each such proposal shall not exceed**  
23 **three hundred (300) words in length."; and**

24 **WHEREAS, Legislative Council representatives were given a reasonable opportunity to make such**  
25 **comments; and**

26 **WHEREAS, the Council's preparation and filing of the analysis and arguments as mandated by the**  
27 **Election Ordinance does not constitute support for or opposition to the Initiative.**

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby directs**  
29 **that the attached Analysis and Popular Arguments Concerning Initiative No. IN-01-**  
30 **2010, "Regulating Salary Increase(s) of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council" shall**  
31 **be filed with the Election Board on June 8, 2010.**

6 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
