

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Endorsing Rodney Glassman as the United States Senate Candidate for Arizona)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-208**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with the**  
2 **authority to "consult with the Congress of the United States. . ." and to "promote,**  
3 **protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare**  
4 **of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1,**  
5 **(j),(c)(2)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, in November 2010, the State of Arizona will hold an election to elect a candidate to the**  
7 **United States Senate for Arizona; and**

8 **WHEREAS, former City of Tucson Councilman Rodney Glassman, a longtime resident of Southern**  
9 **Arizona, has demonstrated a strong commitment and track record of serving the**  
10 **working families of Southern Arizona through his public service and community work;**  
11 **and**

12 **WHEREAS, Rodney Glassman recognizes and supports the unique trust relationship between the**  
13 **United States of America and sovereign Native American tribes such as the Tohono**  
14 **O'odham Nation; and**

15 **WHEREAS, Rodney Glassman has worked collaboratively with the Tohono O'odham Nation on**  
16 **important economic development issues; and**

17 **WHEREAS, during the May general session, Mr. Glassman presented information and answered**  
18 **questions about his candidacy before the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**


19 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council endorses and supports Rodney Glassman as**  
20 **the U.S. Senate candidate for the State of Arizona, the Council also encourages the**  
21 **Nation's members to vote as they deem appropriate.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
23 **endorses and supports Rodney Glassman as the U.S. Senate candidate for the State of**  
24 **Arizona.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
26 **of JUNE, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,160.70 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
27 **230.10[05] NOT VOTING; and 204.70 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Article VI, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
29 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
31 **Stat. 984).**
