| 11 | United States of America and sovereign Native American tribes such as the Tohono |
| 12 | O'odham Nation; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, Vince Rabago understands the importance and benefit of an effective and productive |
| 14 | state-tribal relationship; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, during the May general session, Mr. Rabago presented information and answered |
| 16 | questions about his candidacy before the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council endorses and supports Vince Rabago's |
| 18 | candidacy for Arizona Attorney General, the Council also encourages the Nation's |
| 19 | members to vote as they deem appropriate. |
