

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services, Division
of Management of Health, Strategic Prevention Framework Tribal Incentive
Grant Acct #11-1485 for the FY 2011)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-219

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Management of Health**
2 **directs services that provide substance abuse, mental health, and prevention services;**
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Division of Management of Health received the Strategic Prevention Framework**
5 **Tribal Incentive Grant to design and implement a Tohono O'odham Nation Strategic**
6 **Plan and establish prevention programs within each District to reduce substance**
7 **abuse and related health problems that include suicide, diabetes, depression, fetal**
8 **alcohol syndrome and premature death rates; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the grant amount of \$600,800.00 for the second budget year period from July 1, 2010**
10 **through June 30, 2011, for year two of a five-year grant for a total amount of**
11 **\$3,004,000.00; and**

12 **WHEREAS, of the total grant amount of \$600,800.00, the budget for Year Two reflects the current**
13 **indirect costs of 17.3% in the amount of \$52,588.02; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the second year award in the amount of \$600,800.00 was reviewed and approved by**
15 **Health and Human and the Budget & Finance Committees and is hereby submitted for**
16 **review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 18 **1. Hereby approves and authorizes expenditures for a SAMSHA-funded Strategic**
19 **Prevention Framework Tribal Incentive Grant as stated in the attached budget in**
20 **the amount of \$600,800.00 of which \$52,588.02 is for indirect costs at 17.3%, for the**
21 **second year from July 1, 2010 thru June 30, 2011 of a 5 year grant.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorize the**
23 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
24 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
25 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
27 **of JUNE, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**
29 **Section 1 (D) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
30 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
31 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
