10	the communities' budget amendments submitted by the Gu Achi District and

15	#2) and Palo Verde Stand (Amendment #3) Communities as attached hereto.

17	Distribution of \$1,863,072.77 to the Gu Achi District.
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Gu Achi District Council has the authority to modify its Fiscal
19	Year 2010 budget in accordance with protocols set forth by this Council. Any
20	amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the Gu Achi District's Fiscal Year
21	2010 budget shall be approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
