

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving an Amendment to the FY 2010 Budget of the Election Board to add \$18,879.00
in Order to Conduct a Special Election for Initiative No. IN-01-2010)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-236

1 WHEREAS, by Legislative Order No. 10-188 the Legislative Council of the Nation called for a special
2 election for August 7, 2010 to allow the Tohono O'odham Nation members to vote on
3 Initiative Petition No. IN-01-2010, entitled "Regulating Salary Increase(s) of the Tohono
4 O'odham Legislative Council"; and

5 WHEREAS, the Uniform Election Ordinance, Ordinance No. 03-86, provides the Election Board of
6 the Nation with the full power, jurisdiction and authority to conduct initiative
7 elections in accordance with Article XII and other relevant provisions of the Uniform
8 Election Ordinance; and

9 WHEREAS, Election Board has prepared a budget indicating in which line items additional
10 monies will be needed for the FY-2010 Special Initiative Election: District Election
11 Board Members: \$13,750.00, Mileage: \$2,205.00, Advertisement: \$2,624.00, Food:
12 \$300.00; and

13 WHEREAS, the current Election Board base budget amount of \$132,438.42 does not include
14 enough funding to support the costs associated with conducting the special election
15 called for by Legislative Order No. 10-188; and

16 WHEREAS, the attached amendment to the FY 2010 budget of the Election Board adds \$18,879.00
17 to the Election Office budget to provide for costs associated with conducting the
18 special election called for by Legislative Order No. 10-188.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 20 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the attached amendment to the
21 FY 2010 budget of the Election Board in the amount of \$18,879.00 and authorizes
22 the Election Board to expend the funds.
- 23 2. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes a one-time appropriation in
24 the amount of \$18,879.00 from the surplus general fund of the Nation.

25 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
26 Chairperson and any designated official to expand and administer the budget as
27 attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funding level shall be
28 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

29 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH Day
30 of JUNE, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,408.40 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
31 -01- NOT VOTING; and 187.10[04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article
32 VI, Section 1 (d)(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
33 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
34 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
35 Stat. 984).
