24		by \$4,000 and 772 - RM Building by \$8,500 for a total increase to these Line Items by
25		\$20,500; and
26	WHEREAS,	the new line item amount of \$75,500 and the increase to existing line items by $$20,500$
27		adds up to the total of \$96,000.00 that will help Real Property Management repair and
28		perform maintenance duties to the Tohono O'odham Nation / DaVita Dialysis Center
