

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving of Gu-Vo Community Budget Amendment No. 1 in the Amount of
\$18,920.40 for FY' 2010)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-248

1 **WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District Governing Council did meet on June 19, 2010 to approve the Gu-Vo**
2 **Community Budget Amendment No. 1 for FY' 2010; and**

3 **WHEREAS, Gu-Vo Community is requesting adjustment to the justification and adding funding**
4 **to line items that are depleting in their FY' 2010 Budget to assist the Community**
5 **Members; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the community is increasing and decreasing line items in their FY' 2010 Budget to**
7 **assist the Community members, which are as follows; increased line items are 612,**
8 **620, 722, 812, 854, and decrease line items 712, 772, 774, 810, 852, 860; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the proposed amendment from the Gu-Vo Community has gone through proper**
10 **reviews from the Gu-Vo District and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Budget & Finance**
11 **Committee; and**

12 **WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Budget & Finance Committee to approve Amendment**
13 **No. 1 for the Gu-Vo Community amending justification.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
15 **the Budget Amendment No. 1 for Gu-Vo Community is adding funds in line items that**
16 **are depleting and amending justification of line item 854 Clothing Allowance, the**
17 **original justification states;**

18 ***"To provide funding for the purchase of clothing items for community Member's***
19 ***school children, allocated at; Homebase - Pre School @ \$250.00 per student... Budget***
20 ***@ 25 children, Kindergarten - 8th Grade @ \$300.00 per ... Budget @ 50 children, 9th -***
21 ***12th Grade @\$350.00 per ... Budget @ 35 students. The 8 summer youth workers are***
22 ***excluded. On a First Come First Serve Basis."***

23 **And the amended justification that has been added is as follows;**

24 ***"\$1,031.00 budget for Higher Education Students @ \$300.00 per student x 5 students.***
25 ***First Come First Serve Basis until funds are depleted."***

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Gu-Vo District reserves the right to modify its budget according**
27 **to the Tohono O'odham Nation's process, but any amendments affecting the funds or**
28 **funding shall be approved by the Legislative Council.**
