16		are depleting and amending justification of line item 854 Clothing Allowance, the
17		original justification states;
18		"To provide funding for the purchase of clothing items for community Member's
19		school children, allocated at; Homebase - Pre School @ \$250.00 per student Budget
20		@ 25 children, Kindergarten – 8th Grade @ \$300.00 per Budget @ 50 children, 9th –
21		12th Grade @\$350.00 per Budget @ 35 students. The 8 summer youth workers are
22		excluded. On a First Come First Serve Basis."
23		And the amended justification that has been added is as follows;
24		"\$1,031.00 budget for Higher Education Students @ \$300.00 per student x 5 students.
25		First Come First Serve Basis until funds are depleted."
