

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Chukut Kuk District FY2010 Budget Amendment No.1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 10-249

1 **WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District Council did meet on May 1, 2010 in San Miguel at which a**
2 **quorum was present; and**
3 **WHEREAS, budget amendment no. 1 was presented to Chukut Kuk District Council for approval;**
4 **and**
5 **WHEREAS, Chukut Kuk District Council did approve FY 2010 Budget Modification No. 1 by district**
6 **resolution no. 2010-20; and**
7 **WHEREAS, this amendment is to carryover savings of \$83,799.30 in the FY 2009 general budget**
8 **and savings of \$102,996.31 in the supplement budget to the FY 2010 community**
9 **budgets; and**
10 **WHEREAS, the communities of West Villages and San Miguel have decided to use their**
11 **supplement carryover savings in their FY 2011 budgets; and**
12 **WHEREAS, Tecolote community has decided to deposit \$38,512.07 in an interest bearing account**
13 **for future use by the Tecolote community; and**
14 **WHEREAS, new line items and/or justifications have been added to the following community**
15 **budgets: Vamori, San Miguel, West Villages, Williams, Horseshoe, Tecolote, Ak**
16 **Komelik and Miguel; and**
17 **WHEREAS, budget modification no. 1 was presented to the TOLC Budget & Finance Committee for**
18 **review.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Communities are authorized to carryover the**

7 VI, Section 1 (d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
8 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
9 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
10 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
