8		amount of \$400,000 for the first year of a three year grant (Attachment A); and
9	WHEREAS,	the Notice of Award was received for Fiscal Year 2008 on June 20, 2007 in the amount
10		of \$400,000 for the second year of a three year grant (Attachment B); and
11	WHEREAS,	the Notice of Award for year three of the grant was received on July 17, 2009 for
12		approval of carry over funds in the amount of \$297,616 from year 2 into Year 3 and the
13		Federal grant agency also approved a 12 month no-cost extension with a new project
14		end date of September 30, 2010 (Attachment C); and
15	WHEREAS,	the total including year 2 into Year 3 carry over in the amount of \$297,616 and
16		unexpended funds from year 3 funding is \$100,448.14 for a total of \$398,064.14; and
17	WHEREAS,	the proposed Youth Suicide Prevention grant budget amendment reflects
18		DECREASING line item 650-Tuition and Registration, 655-Lodging, 660-Travel
19		Expenses, 661-Mileage POV, 710-Utilities, 711-Communication Expenses and 712-Gas,
20		Oil, and Coolants and INCREASING line items 810-Professional Services and 860-
21		Special Activities from the combined carryover and unexpended funds is \$398,064.14;
