**(Approving Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services -**  
**Management of Health Youth Suicide Prevention Grant Budget Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-261**

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Management of Health Division of**  
2 **Prevention provides prevention services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Division of Behavioral Health submitted an application to the U.S. Department of**  
4 **Health and Human Services/Center for Mental Health for a Youth Suicide Prevention**  
5 **Program grant to provide services to reduce youth suicide and increase wellness on**  
6 **May 06, 2006; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Notice of Award was received for Fiscal Year 2007 on October 01, 2006 in the**  
8 **amount of \$400,000 for the first year of a three year grant (Attachment A); and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Notice of Award was received for Fiscal Year 2008 on June 20, 2007 in the amount**  
10 **of \$400,000 for the second year of a three year grant (Attachment B); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Notice of Award for year three of the grant was received on July 17, 2009 for**  
12 **approval of carry over funds in the amount of \$297,616 from year 2 into Year 3 and the**  
13 **Federal grant agency also approved a 12 month no-cost extension with a new project**  
14 **end date of September 30, 2010 (Attachment C); and**

15 **WHEREAS, the total including year 2 into Year 3 carry over in the amount of \$297,616 and**  
16 **unexpended funds from year 3 funding is \$100,448.14 for a total of \$398,064.14; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the proposed Youth Suicide Prevention grant budget amendment reflects**  
18 **DECREASING line item 650-Tuition and Registration, 655-Lodging, 660-Travel**  
19 **Expenses, 661-Mileage POV, 710-Utilities, 711-Communication Expenses and 712-Gas,**  
20 **Oil, and Coolants and INCREASING line items 810-Professional Services and 860-**  
21 **Special Activities from the combined carryover and unexpended funds is \$398,064.14;**  
22 **and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Youth Suicide Prevention grant carry-over and no-cost extension in the amount**  
24 **of \$398,064.14, for Year 3 of the grant ending September 30, 2010 is hereby submitted**  
25 **for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
27 **approves and authorizes:**

- 28 **1. Youth Suicide Prevention Grant amendment which reflects decreasing line item(s)**  
29 **650-Tuition & Registration, 655-Lodging, 660-Travel, 661-Mileage POV, 710-**  
30 **Utilities, 711-Communications Expense, and 712-Gas, Oil, and Coolant and**  
31 **increase line item(s) 810-Professional Services and 860-Special Activities.**

6                   **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels shall**  
7                   **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

8 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
9 **of JULY, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
10 **-0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**  
11 **Section 1 (d)(2)(3) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
12 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
13 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
14 **Stat. 984).**


