

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Amending Resolution No. 05-365, "Road Priorities FY2005 thru FY2010" to**  
**update Road Priorities)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-262**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (The "Nation") is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe and**  
2 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is the governing**  
3 **body of the Nation with the responsibility to advance the safety issues relating to the**  
4 **Nation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Indian Reservation Route 101 (Sells Main Street) is subject to severe flooding that has**  
6 **caused the death of four tribal members in the last few years thus making it a current**  
7 **and future safety hazard to the Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Planning Department would like to amend Resolution 05-365: The Nation's Road**  
9 **Priorities to include the Sells Drainage Project "Saving O'odham in Sells" (SOS) as the**  
10 **Nation's road priority number 1. (see attachment A); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Sells Drainage Project "Saving O'odham in Sells" (SOS) proposes to construct a one**  
12 **hundred year flood drainage system and bridge along Indian Reservation Route 101**  
13 **(Sells Main Street); and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOT) has announced the availability of funding for**  
15 **National infrastructure investments under the Transportation, Housing, and Urban**  
16 **Development, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act for 2010 (see federal register**  
17 **No. 70 April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2010 p.21695); and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee has reviewed the project concept and understands**  
19 **the project is dependant on funding availability from the Department of**  
20 **Transportation (DOT) to construct the Sells Drainage Project "Saving O'odham in**  
21 **Sells" (SOS) and the reason to move the project as the Nation's road priority number**  
22 **1.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council has reviewed the need for**  
24 **amending Resolution 05-365: The Nation's Road Priorities and approves including the**  
25 **Sells Drainage project "Saving O'odham in Sells" (SOS) as the Nation's road priority**  
26 **number 1 (see attachment A) based on funding availability out of the Department of**  
27 **Transportation.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
29 **of JULY, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
30 **-03- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**  
31 **Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**  
32 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
33 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


