1	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power "to manage any
2	funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution of the
3	Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and
4	WHEREAS, the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee and the Executive Office reviewed the
5	revenue projections and available revenue for FY 2011; and
6	WHEREAS, pursuant to Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 09-267, the Nation
7	established a minimum General Fund Surplus Reserve of \$17,219,789.00 and amount
8	equal to 25% of the projected FY2010 General Fund budget; and
9	WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 09-267 provides for the Legislative
10	Council to appropriate funds from the General Fund Surplus Reserve to address
11	shortfall in funds available from the Nation's approved operating budgets; and
12	WHEREAS, the Nation's Treasurer has calculated that \$9,890,616.75 is needed from the General
13	Fund Surplus Reserve to fund the Nation's FY 2011 General Fund Budget; and
14	WHEREAS, the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee and the Executive Office recommend
15	the adoption of the FY 2011 revenue projections in the amount of \$72,269,101.40 to
16	fund the Nation's General Fund budgets for FY 2011 including \$9,890,616.75 from the
17	FY 2011 General Fund Surplus Reserve.
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
19	approves FY 2011 projected revenues in the amount of \$72,269,101.40 including
20	\$9,890,616.75 from the FY 2011 General Fund Surplus Reserve for the purpose of
21	funding the FY 2011 General Fund budgets of the Tohono O'odham Nation.
