7	proposal to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the Brownfields
8	Section 128(a) Program in the amount of \$70,000.00 for continued funding; and
9	WHEREAS, the Brownfields Section 128(a) Grant would allow the Program to continue to identify,
10	assess and conduct oversight at cleanup activities where contamination exists
11	throughout the Nation.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts
13	the FY2011 proposal amount of \$70,000.00 for continued funding for the Brownfields
14	128(a) Grant.
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the
16	expenditure of funds according to this budget, which shall be in effect from October
17	1, 2010 to September 30, 2011.
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
19	Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
20	attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be
21	submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
