

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Brownfields Proposal and approval of the FY2011 Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 10-299

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is devoted to the goals of protecting the environment and**
2 **safe guarding the health and well being of the Nation's members; and**

3 **WHEREAS, in the past and present, sites of concerns with potential of contamination have**
4 **threatened the environment, health and well-being of the Nation and its members;**
5 **and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Environmental Protection Office (EPO) has submitted a**
7 **proposal to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the Brownfields**
8 **Section 128(a) Program in the amount of \$70,000.00 for continued funding; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Brownfields Section 128(a) Grant would allow the Program to continue to identify,**
10 **assess and conduct oversight at cleanup activities where contamination exists**
11 **throughout the Nation.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
13 **the FY2011 proposal amount of \$70,000.00 for continued funding for the Brownfields**
14 **128(a) Grant.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the**
16 **expenditure of funds according to this budget, which shall be in effect from October**
17 **1, 2010 to September 30, 2011.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
19 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
20 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
21 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29TH Day**
23 **of JULY, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,408.40 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
24 **187.10 [01] NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
25 **VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**
