

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Acceptance of the Clean Air Act Proposal and approval of the FY2011 Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-300**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is devoted to the goals of protecting the environment and**  
2 **safe guarding the health and well being of the Nation's members; and**

3 **WHEREAS, in the past and present, air quality issues have threatened the environment, health**  
4 **and well-being, and the sovereignty of the Nation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Environmental Protection Office (EPO) has submitted a**  
6 **proposal to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Clean Air Act (CAA)**  
7 **program in the amount of \$85,000.00 for continued funding to support air quality**  
8 **activities; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Clean Air Act grant would allow the Nation to finalize the Point Source Emissions**  
10 **Inventory and Needs Assessment, develop a Monitoring Plan; develop a Quality**  
11 **Assurance Project Plan and participation in local, regional and national initiatives.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**  
13 **the FY2011 proposal amount of \$85,000 for continued funding for the CAA Grant.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the**  
15 **expenditure of funds according to this budget, which shall be in effect from October**  
16 **1, 2010 to September 30, 2011.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
18 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
19 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**  
20 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
22 **of JULY, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,408.40 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
23 **187.10 [02] NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**  
24 **VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
25 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
26 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
27 **Stat. 984).**
