

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the 2011 budget for account 11-1136 a federal grant administered by the
Office of Violence against Women from the Recovery Act Grants to Indian
Tribal Governments Program)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-305

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Office of the Prosecutor has successfully applied for and**
2 **received an award administered by the Office on Violence against Women (OVW) from**
3 **the Recovery Act Grants to Indian Tribal Governments Program funded through the**
4 **US Department of Justice (DOJ) for the amount of \$899,983.00 under grant number**
5 **2009-EG-S6-0030 the grant amount is funding for a three year period beginning**
6 **October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2012; and**

7 **WHEREAS, these funds will be used to fund a dedicated prosecutorial team expanding our**
8 **prosecutorial focus to increasing accountability for Sexual Assault (SA) while**
9 **continuing our committed focus to Domestic Violence (DV) and to explore the**
10 **protocols and sustainability of a Sexual Assault Response Team; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the budget for FY 2011 (October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011) in the amount of**
12 **(\$297,600.50) for said grant has been put in tribal format and is before the Tohono**
13 **O'odham Legislative Council for review; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the items being budgeted for are estimated and may be adjusted at a later date if**
15 **needed; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the remaining \$316,724.75 will be used for October 1, 2011 through September 30,**
17 **2012, as appropriate.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
19 **accepts and approves the second year's budget, attached hereto, for FY2011 beginning**
20 **October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011 in the amount of \$297,600.50.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**
22 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
23 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**
24 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29TH Day**
26 **of JULY, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**
28 **Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham**
29 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
30 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
