

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services Recovery  
Community Services Program FY2011)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-316**

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Recovery Community Services**  
2 **Program provides prevention support recovery services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Recovery Community Services Program submitted an application to the U.S.**  
4 **Department of Health and Human Services/Center for Substance Abuse Treatment for**  
5 **a Recovery Community Services Program grant to provide peer-to-peer prevention**  
6 **programs to support individuals in recovery and their families on March 31, 2006; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Notice of Awards were received for Fiscal Years 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 in the**  
8 **amount of \$350,000 for each year of a four-year grant; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the grant is scheduled to be awarded a no-cost extension of the fourth year for FY2011;**  
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, the grant is scheduled to be awarded a no-cost extension in the amount of \$184,393.60**  
12 **for the no-cost extension for FY2011; and**

13 **WHEREAS, of the total grant amount of \$184,393.60 the no-cost extension budget proposed for**  
14 **FY2011 reflects 17.31% in indirect costs; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Recovery Community Services Program budget of \$184,393.60 for the no-cost**  
16 **extension of Year 4 of the grant is hereby submitted for review and approval by the**  
17 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 19 **1. Hereby approves and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the FY 2011**  
20 **Recovery Community Services Program grant attached budget in the amount of**  
21 **\$184,393.60 for the no-cost extension continuation of the fourth year of a four year**  
22 **grant.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
24 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
25 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall be**  
26 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
28 **of JULY, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
29 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI,**  
30 **Section 1 (d)(2)(3) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
31 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
33 **Stat. 984).**
