3	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated and wishes to continue operating Child Care
4	Services to provide child care services to its young tribal members; and
5	WHEREAS, the Executive Branch developed and obtained committee approval of the following
6	Budgets as attached and incorporated by this reference, to be effective October 1, 2010
7	through September 30, 2011 and requests authorization to expend funds for the FY
8	2011 Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) in the amount of \$903,759.00 in the
9	following budgets:
10	1. FY 2011 CCDF Mandatory Funds - \$506,128.32 + \$67,565.68 (IDC) = \$573,694.00.
11	2. FY 2011 CCDF Discretionary Funds - \$281,385.34 + \$48,679.66 (IDC) = \$330,065.00
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
13	approves the above listed CCDF Mandatory Funds Budget, and CCDF Discretionary
14	Funds Budget for period October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011.
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Branch is hereby authorized to expend funds for the
16	program listed herein above and as attached in the amounts indicated, effective
17	October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011 for the FY 2011 Child Care and
18	Development Fund Budgets:
19	1. FY 2011 CCDF Mandatory Funds - \$506,128.32 + \$67,565.68 (IDC) = \$573,694.00.
20	2. FY 2011 CCDF Discretionary Funds - \$281,385.34 + \$48,679.66 (IDC) = \$330,065.00.

22	Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are authorized to
23	negotiate and expend the budget, provided however, that any amendments affecting
24	the funds or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for further prior approval.
