1	WHEREAS,	the San Lucy District Council passed Resolution No. 30-86 appointing persons to serve
2		on a District created Hiatit O'odham Policy Board ("Policy Board") as a gesture of
3		support for the endeavors of the Hia-Ced O'odham and sought the Tohono O'odham
4		Legislative Council's acceptance of such appointments; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council enacted Resolution No. 490-86 ratifying the
6		San Lucy District's appointments to the Policy Board, referred the Policy Board's
7		Statement of Organization and By-laws ("Bylaws") to the Rules Committee by
8		Resolution No. 19-87, and adopted the Policy Board's Bylaws, which recognized the
9		Policy Board as a District established Board, by Resolution No. 99-87 (veto overridden
10		by Resolution No. 120-87); and
11	WHEREAS,	the San Lucy District Council enacted Resolution No. 11-25-97 which, in part, repealed
12		the District's establishment of the Policy Board; and
13	WHEREAS,	the San Lucy District Council affirmed its termination of the Policy Board by
14		Resolution No. 05-10-95; and
15	WHEREAS,	the To hono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution Nos. 490-86, 19-86, 99-87 were not an experimentation and the control of the
16		rescinded but they pertained to a San Lucy District Board that no longer existed; and
17	WHEREAS,	an Advisory Committee ("Executive Advisory Committee") was subsequently
18		$established \ by \ executive \ order \ on \ July \ 25, 1996 \ to \ assist \ the \ Hia-Ced\ O'odham\ Program$
19		Office, an Executive Branch Program established by Papago Tribal Council Resolution
20		No. 363-85, with completion of the Program Office's goals; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council regularly approved the Program Office
22		budgetsthatincludedfundingtoreimburseExecutiveAdvisoryCommitteemembers
23		for mileage expenses incurred to attend monthly Executive Advisory Committee
24		meetings; and
25	WHEREAS.	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the efforts of the individuals who
26		served in good faith as appointed or non-appointed Executive Advisory Committee
27		members; and
28	WHEREAS,	notwithstanding the method of creating the Executive Advisory Committee and the
29		work it performed, the Legislative and Executive Branches agree that it would be in the

2	Legislative Council resolution, rather than relying on an entity created solely by					
3	executive order; and					
4	WHEREAS, the Legislative Domestic Affairs Committee and Rules Committee have reviewed and					
5	recommend the adoption of the "Bylaws of the Hia-Ced O'odham Committee," which					
6	are incorporated by this reference.					
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:					
8	1. Repeals Legislative Council Resolution Numbers 490-86, 19-87, and 99-87.					
9	2. Adopts the "Bylaws of the Hia-Ced O'odham Committee," which shall supersede and					
10	replace any previously approved bylaws of the Hia-Ced or Hiatit O'odhan					
11	committee or board.					
12	3. The Hia-Ced O'odham Committee established by this resolution shall replace an					
13	Hia-Ced or Hiatit O'odham committee or board previously established or approve					
14	by the Legislative Council .					
15	4. Ratifies all otherwise lawful actions by and monetary disbursements to person					
16	who served as members of the Executive Advisory Committee, with or withou					
17	official appointment.
