## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approving the Acceptance of Grant Funds from the Department of the Interior Fish and Wildlife Service's Tribal Wildlife Grant Program for the Flora and Fauna Inventory of the Baboquivari Mountain Region)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-368

1	WHEREAS,	a 2-year grant proposal was submitted to the U.S. Fish and whome service's Iribal
2		Wildlife Grants program for FY 2010 to inventory the flora and fauna in the Coyote,
3		Quinlan and Baboquivari Mountains, otherwise known as the Baboquivari Mountain
4		Region; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Baboquivari Mountain Region represents the most biologically diverse area of the
6		Nation and has been identified as one of four critical cross-border wildlife corridors
7		in Southern Arizona; and
8	WHEREAS,	minimal formal research has been done and baseline data is needed in order to
9		$\mathbf{manage} \ \mathbf{and} \ \mathbf{mitigate} \ \mathbf{current} \ \mathbf{and} \ \mathbf{future} \ \mathbf{threats} \ \mathbf{to} \ \mathbf{the} \ \mathbf{ecological} \ \mathbf{system} \ \mathbf{ofthe} \ \mathbf{Nation}.$
10		This information is a key component in the management of the Nation's natural
11		resources and in the protection of rare, threatened, endangered and culturally
12		sensitive species and habitats that are part of the natural and cultural heritage of the
13		Nation; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Wildlife and Vegetation Management Program was established in 2000 by the
15		Nation's  Legislative  Council  (Res.  No.  2000-276)  to  assist  the  Nation  in  the  conservation,
16		protection  and  management  of biological  resources  and  implement  sound  biological
17		studies; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Wildlife and Vegetation Management Program is charged, through its program
19		objectives, to seek funding from  outside  sources  in  order  to  enhance  its  ability  to  meet
20		goals and objectives and to reduce the Nation's financial commitment for its
21		operations; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Wildlife and Vegetation Management Program is further charged through its
23		program objectives, with the inventory of all the flora and fauna of the Nation; and

1	WHEREAS, the Executive Office, the Natural Resource Oversight Committee, Grants and Contracts					
2	Office, and the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed and approved this budget.					
3	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves					
4	and authorizes expenditures for acceptance of funds granted by the Fish and Wildlife					
5	Service's Tribal Wildlife Grants Program in the amount of \$200,000.00 for the 2-year					
6	Flora and Fauna Inventory of the Baboquivari Mountain Region and supports the					
7	Wildlife and Vegetation Management Program in the implementation of the Flora and					
8	Fauna Inventory.					
9	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the					
10	Wildlife and Vegetation Management Program budget in the amount of \$127,127.38					
11	commencing on October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011, and the remaining funds					
12	in the amount of \$72,872.62 will be applied to FY 2012.					
13	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the					
14	Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as					
15	attached, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding					
16	levels shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham					
17	Legislative Council.
